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Update from SBSTTA-27 in Panama



- Overall tense discussions, increasingly political exchanges and lots of bracketed text for COP.
- Global review of collective progress on the implementation of the GBF: difficult discussions – forward-looking messages and pathways secured.
- IPBES – bracketed text on welcoming TCA and Nexus.
- Scientific and technical needs – Some Parties blocking requests to the Executive Secretary for further work (either on the gender plan of action, the pollution and biodiversity or spatial planning), debate over whether to accept referring to ‘areas of work’ within programmes of work, long discussions on sustainable supply chains/due diligence/supply chains decoupled from deforestation, etc.
- Biodiversity and climate change: mandate of the CBD constantly being questioned in relation to climate change, supplement to the voluntary guidelines is bracketed.
- SB8j – tense discussions also questioning the legitimacy of the UN PFII and the use of the seven sociocultural regions for representation in the IIFB.

Fifth TSC-IGAG Meeting in Montreal, Canada



- Draft options to further address the technological, technical and institutional capability gaps identified by Parties
- Draft terms of reference for the independent evaluation of the relevance and effectiveness of the long-term strategic framework for capacity-building and development and the technical and scientific cooperation mechanism
- Identification and mapping of relevant initiatives and partnerships supporting capacity-building and development for the implementation of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework

Fifth TSC-IAG Meeting in Montreal, Canada (continued)



- Draft guidance for developing the biennial workplans of the regional and subregional technical and scientific cooperation support centres
- Workplan of the Informal Advisory Group on Technical and Scientific Cooperation for the intersessional period
- Other matters
 - practical guide on capacity-building and development for biodiversity
 - online course will be developed based on the guide
- Conclusions and recommendations
