
Strengthen Capacity-Building and Scientific and Technical Cooperation for Biodiversity

- Two-stage selection process from July 2023 until october 2024 (COP16)
- Why applying to host a subregional Technical and Scientific Cooperation Support Centre?
 - ☐ Strong overlap with tasks requested from KCBD
 - ☐ Minimize fragmentation in Knowledge Management
 - ☐ Unique opportunity to strengthen C institutionalize many processes e.g., inter and intra institutional collaborations



An updated governance model










Challenges of the European subregional TSC







