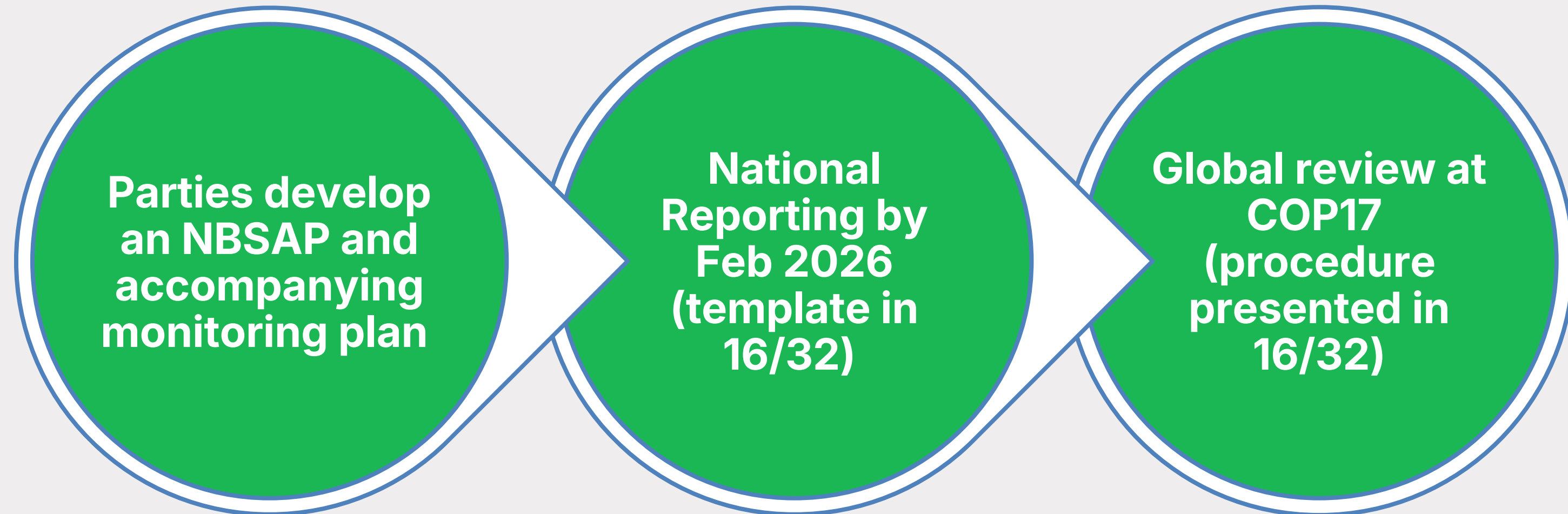

- **Encouraged to use headline indicators as well as other relevant indicators (see dec 15/6)**
- **Methods for indicators 16/31)**

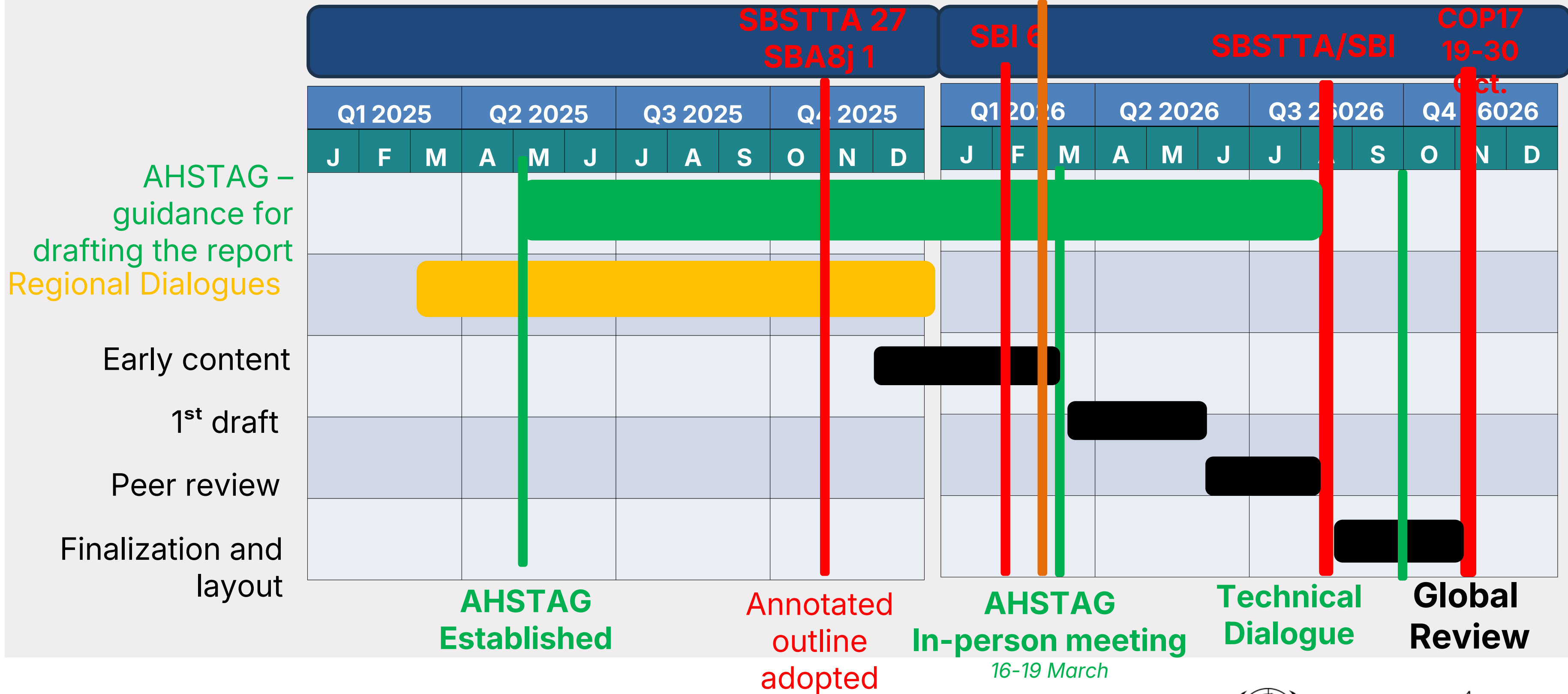
- **Headline and binary indicators are part of the reporting template**
- Parties may report headline indicator data using national sources or global estimates
- Other indicators are optional, but encouraged

- **Analysis of progress will be based on indicators**



Timeline of the global review (according to 16/32)

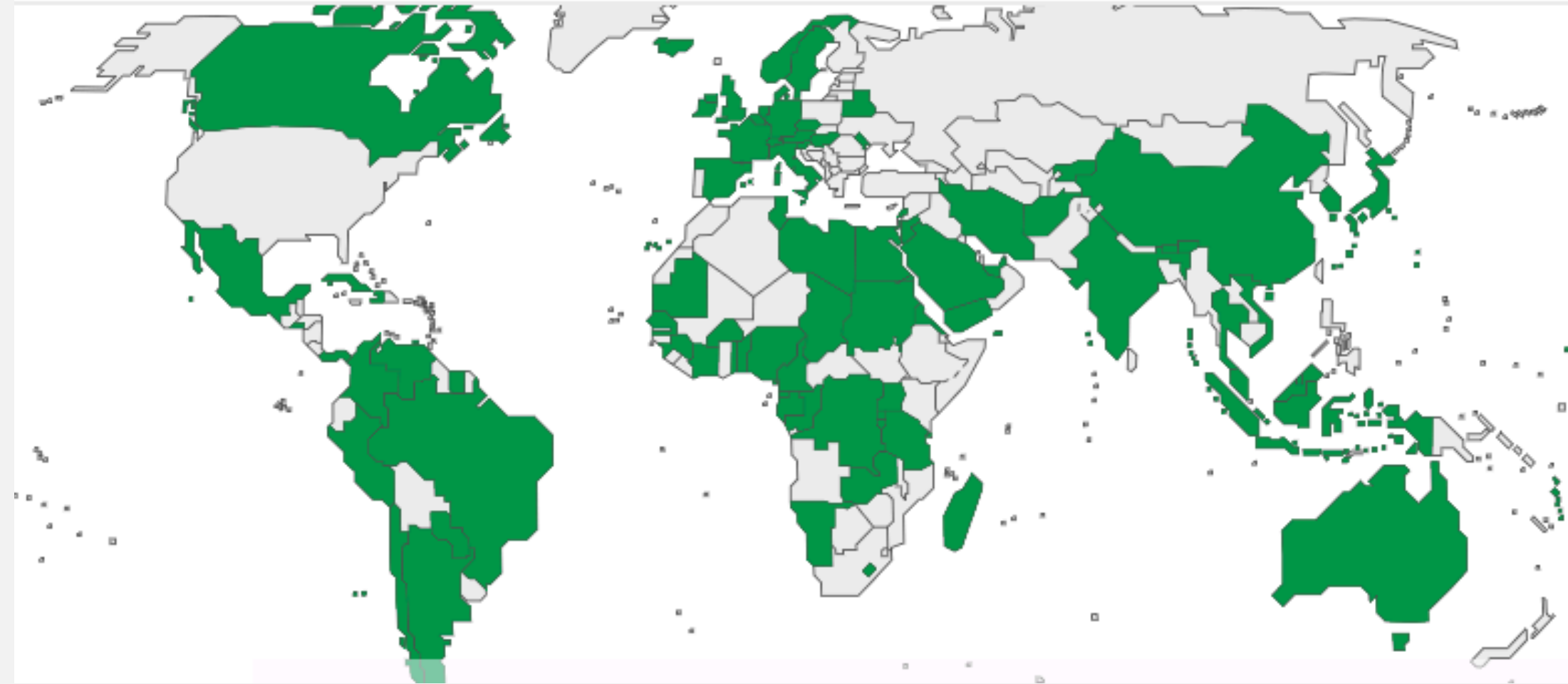

NBSAPs, National targets

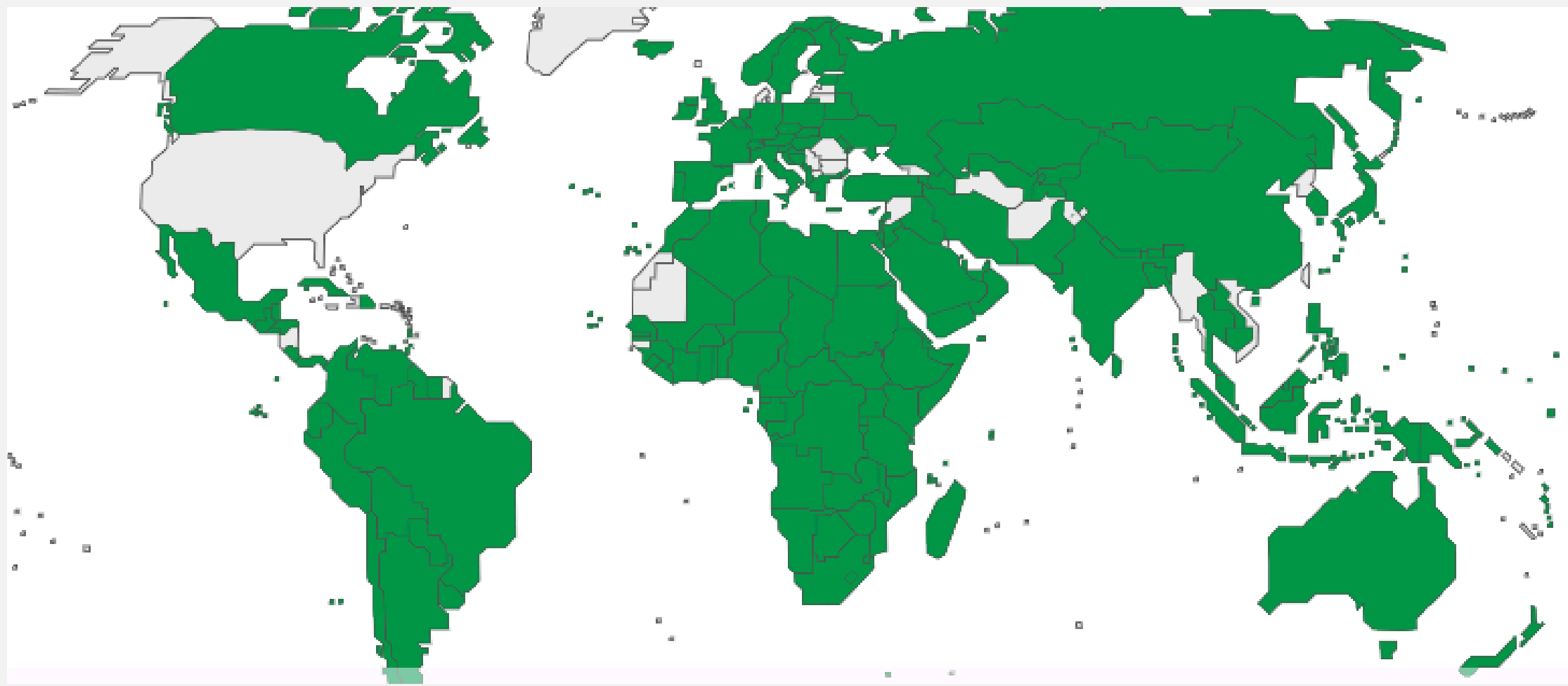
88

Actors other than national government

- Decision COP 16/32:
 - Recalls invitation (COP 15/6) to develop and share commitments contributing to NBSAPs and KMGBF
 - On a voluntary basis
 - Elements and principles in Annex II

Actors other than government

○ PRINCIPLES

- Standardized guidelines and templates (*"as simple as possible"*)
- Particular focus on national targets and NBSAPs, or both
- Use of established and available metrics, including relevant indicators, is *"highly recommended"*
- Flexibility in the template
- Recognize countries may have specific modalities

○ MODALITIES

- Online Reporting Tool
- By the actor or the National Focal Point on its behalf
- Automated notification to Parties that wish to be informed
- Non-objection process before publication for NFP who wish to do so
- Withdraw from publication at any time if objection
- Communicate progress towards achievement of the commitments

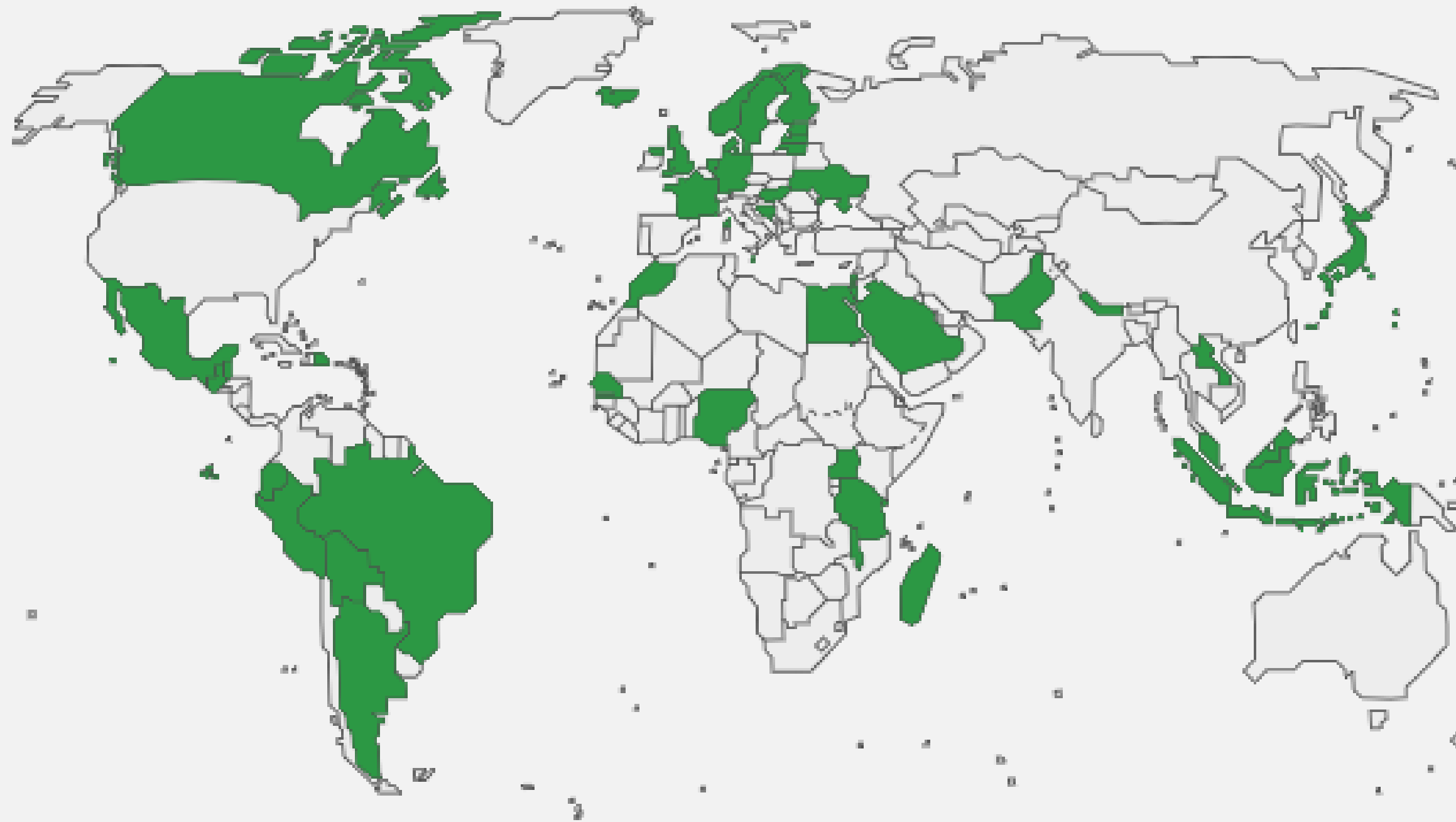
